The meeting organized by the CCIMI and the CCIIM in Tel Aviv on April 6, for the launch of the Morocco-Israel Business Forum scheduled to take place in Marrakech from May 17 to 19, 2022, confirmed the high potential of the sectors jointly identified and the strong interest of operators from both countries for this eminently promising meeting.

However, the context of the end of the international health crisis and the event pressure that followed, created new time constraints, which force us to postpone our Forum to October 25-26, 2022.

This readjustment of the calendar, which will have no impact on our common roadmap, will allow our two chambers to strengthen partnerships with actors related to the development of economic, technological and cultural relations between Morocco and Israel, in a spirit of complementarity, openness and reciprocity.
